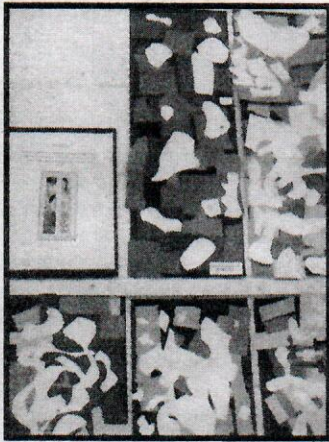


Student Art Showcase Includes Mondrian, Kandinski and more
