It gives me much pleasure to share this report with you. Your investment in the students of Saint John Paul II Regional School and in Catholic education makes a big impact. Thank you for helping us inspire students to lead lives rooted in Christian values, and supporting us in demonstrating how they can make a difference in the world with their gifts and

talents. Strong academic and faith formation programs, a safe and happy campus and tuition assistance for those in need exist at Saint John Paul II Regional School because of your generosity. Thank you for believing in our mission!

In September 2017, we began the process of accreditation which is a self-evaluation process that schools and school systems voluntarily use to demonstrate they are meeting a defined set of research-based performance standards. The standards examine schools in a holistic way, supplementing student-testing data to provide a more complete measure of the school's performance and chart a strategic and realistic course for continuous school improvement.

This fall, we were informed that the Commission on Elementary Schools of the Middle States Association of Colleges and Schools voted to award St. John Paul II Regional School accreditation for the term of seven years. We are thrilled that we will continue to be among the schools throughout the world that meet the internationally recognized standards of quality of the Middle States Association of Colleges and Schools.

We continue to hold the bar high for professional development for all faculty and staff. Teachers participated in professional development

Just as my staff has participated in local professional development, I accompanied them to support their efforts.

Our 2018 graduates were awarded over \$50,000 in scholarships and awards in the areas of academics, athletics and service to others. Our young alumni are leaders in high school and college activities. They are pursuing careers in business, medicine, engineering and religious life.
