



2019-2020 Tuition Rates

Thank you for choosing Saint John Paul II Regional School for your child. We take great pride in providing an educational experience that develops the mind, body and spirit for our diverse student body. We are confident that your child's experience at Saint John Paul II Regional School will serve them well in the future, as well as, be a community of faith and friendship for all of our families.

We know the importance of maintaining both curricular and co-curricular classes for students. Efforts will begin shortly to fill 2019-2020 positions for: art, music, physical education and technology. We are currently searching for a part-time Spanish teacher. We will continue offering our engaging STEM enrichment periods weekly.

Decisions regarding tuition are made with great care by our finance committee to maintain a strong curriculum, safe campus, and variety of programs serving all students. To continue our mission...*empowering students to achieve their academic potential in a faith based environment*, our 2019-2020 tuition rates are as follows:

Catholic-First Child:	\$5,300
Catholic –Second Child discount:	\$4,300
Catholic-Third Child discount:	\$3,480
Non Catholic-All Children:	\$6,700
Preschool:	\$6,500

Administrative Fee of \$200.00 per child is added to our tuition plan. It may be broken out into monthly payments with tuition. This fee helps to cover costs associated with technology use, art program supplies, student information systems such as Homework Now, student educational magazine subscriptions and accident insurance and other expenses that tuition does not cover. These components are necessary to operate a successful elementary school for children today. Fundraising supports some of this expense, but not 100% of the cost.

We respect and are grateful for your commitment to Catholic education for your family. Tuition payment options:

- Option 1:** Pay the school directly the full amount of tuition due on or before July 15, 2019.
- Option 2:** Pay the school directly in two equal installments, the first due on or before July 15, 2019 and the second due on or before January 3, 2020.
- Option 3:** Enroll in the tuition management service and have your tuition payments spread out over a 10-month period (July through April).
