Dear Friends of Saint John Paul II Regional School:

Thank you for your most generous support to our 2015-2016 Annual Fund campaign! Over \$132,000 was donated to our school to support both operating expenses and financial aid needs.

In September, we will embark on our ninth academic year as the Saint John Paul II Regional School community! Each year brings new beginnings, and yes, new challenges “however” we continue to grow and thrive as a Catholic elementary school in the Camden Diocese. Our Annual Fund campaign continues to successfully provide increased support for programs, technology, scholarship and campus needs. Our faculty becomes more knowledgeable and skilled in empowering children at all educational levels, and our program attracts more students to serve each year.

Personally, I have attended the NCEA in San Diego, which provides opportunities to converse with colleagues across the United States. Just as my staff has participated in local professional development I accompanied them to support their efforts. This past spring I had the opportunity to work with approximately 20 teachers in the areas of Art, World Language, Music, Physical Education and Library/Technology to provide them with strategies for classroom management.

This past year, I spent many hours attending workshops and webinars with the state of New Jersey to implement the Free/Reduced Lunch Program. This program provides our students with a more nutritious lunch at no or little cost to families who are eligible for the program. Last school year, over 70 students participated. We then introduced Breakfast in the spring and continue to offer both Breakfast and Lunch to many families who struggle financially. In the 2016-2017 school year, we have 90 students who are eligible.

This continued education allows our school to stay ahead and compete with schools across our state. We continue to stress academics and its importance. Saint John Paul II has maintained standardized test scores with the national average. Our faculty is dedicated to teaching, and ensuring that students will be successful when graduating 8th Grade.

We embrace the diverse, welcoming school that Saint John Paul II Regional School is today! We are very proud of the opportunity that we have to provide so many parents today who seek a safe, faith-based educational environment for their child. Without your continued support and prayers, this would not be possible!

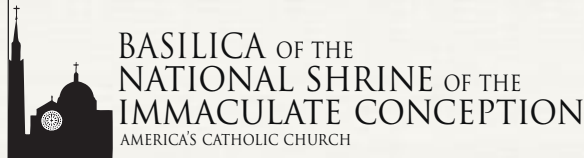
## **WE LOVE OUR MOMS**

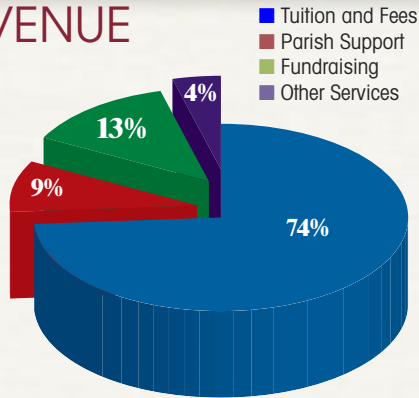

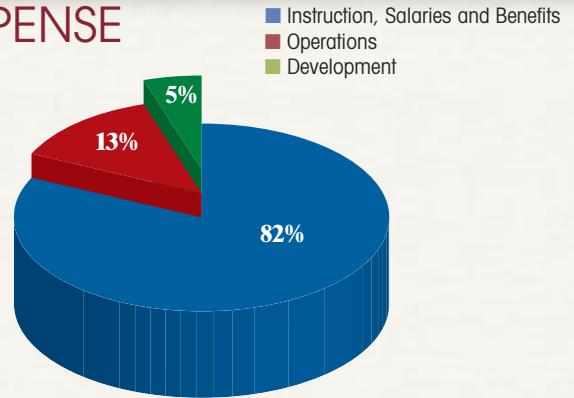
